Our rationale for transacting (or not transacting) in a given country varies, but generally speaking we look for political stability, business-friendly policies, clear regulatory frameworks, established financial markets, and a healthy/growing economy. We will occasionally consider a jurisdiction that doesn't presently meet all of the aforementioned criteria, but is making substantial progress toward doing so.
